


NEEDS ACTION... NOT WORDS...





CARBAPENEM RESISTANCE CHENNAI DATA




Clinical outcome among Neutropenic group

Chennai declaration strategy

India needs "An implementable strategy" and NOT "A perfect strategy"

- Asking for a complete and strict antibiotic policy in developing countries may not be an intelligent or immediately viable option.
- In developing countries, rules on antibiotics usage should be liberal at first and then made stricter stepwise..
